- Implementing the program, including an assessment and control of any relevant risks
- Continually monitoring, evaluating and providing feedback to the various stakeholders in the Kurnai College community
- Setting achievable goals and targets
- Evaluation and reflection of programs and practices in order to continuously improve the Kurnai College Sustainable Schools Program
